KEY DATES

August 1stOpening of the competition

October 15th.....Deadline for receipt of application

Mid-November......Scholarships are presented to the three successful applicants at the General Membership Meeting on the 2nd Monday of the month

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Union members (in good standing with the Local) leaving work full-time on an approved leave of absence to
 upgrade their education OR dependants (under the age of 25) of a member (in good standing with the Local)
 continuing with a Post-Secondary Education
- Must be in first year attendance at any recognized University, Teachers College, or Community College in the Province of Ontario

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Duly completed print or digital application form
- Two letters of recommendation. These must be signed and clearly indicate the name and contact information of the person giving the referral. References can be any of the following:
 - Past or present employer
 - Teacher
 - Advisors and coaches
 - Note: References from family members will not be accepted
- Copy of the Letter of Acceptance to a recognized University, Teachers College, or Community College in the Province of Ontario
- · Certified copy of graduation or final marks

APPLICATION FORM

If you are interested in this opportunity, please complete the Scholarship Application Form. Information and printable application forms regarding the scholarships are available from both the website (www.cupe905.com) and the Local's office located at 165 Pony Drive in Newmarket.

All applications to be considered must be fully completed and submitted within the specified time period which is August 1st to October 15th of each calendar year. Any discrepancies or issues arising from this approved policy shall be reported to the General Membership for review and possible amendment. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.

SELECTION

CUPE Local 905 Scholarships are selected through a rigorous process comprised of the following stages:

- 1. The Treasurer will review all applications received for the period beginning August 1st and ending October 15th of each calendar year.
- 2. Evaluation of all applications by the Signing Officers of CUPE Local 905.
- 3. A recommendation from the Treasurer, in consultation with the other Signing Officers, shall be presented to the Executive Board for consideration and endorsement.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications must be on the provided form and must be received by the Vice President of CUPE Local 905 no later than October 15th of each calendar year. All criteria must be adhered to for the application to be reviewed.

- Financial need
- Academic achievement, including grades
- Community / extracurricular involvement
- Leadership
- Aptitude & promise
